1. **Money and Possessions: the Quest for Contentment** (Christian Life Skills) Appearances and lifestyle matter to us. And money---or the lack of it---often determines whether or not we're content. Discover God's view of material wealth, how we're supposed to handle it, and how to live an abundant life, regardless of your financial circumstances. Runs **7 sessions, September 7—October 19** and taught by *Mike & Amy Tubergen*.
  
2. **Lutheran Questions, Lutheran Answers** (Christian Beliefs) Discuss the theology, practice, and structure of the Lutheran church in modern times. Runs every **Sunday, September 7—November 23** and led by *Pastor Koenig*.
  
3. **Light on the Lessons** (Biblical Studies) Study in-depth the context and life application of the weekly Bible readings from worship. Runs **every Sunday** for anyone, including the occasional attendee and guest. Held in the *Fellowship Hall* and taught by *Dick Hein & Bill Howlett*.
  
4. **Environmental Stewardship in the Judeo-Christian Tradition** (Hot Topics) Explore Jewish, Catholic, and Protestant wisdom on the environment. A participant guide and DVD featuring scientists and theologians provide an alternative Christian view, which is countercultural to the views in much of the media. Runs **5 sessions, October 26—November 23**, and led by *Bob Dill*.
  
5. **Characters of the Christmas Story** (Biblical Studies) Explore the lives of Mary, Joseph, Herod, the shepherds, and the unique role of each, surrounding the birth of Christ. Runs **4 sessions, November 30—December 21**, and led by *Bob Brantsch*.
