and ever. Amen

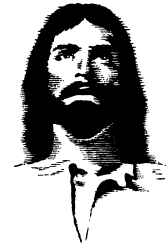
The Apostles' Creed

2nd Article

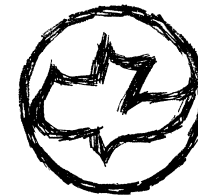


I believe in

Amen.

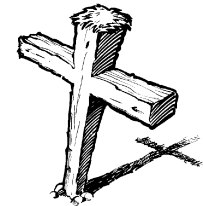


Matthew 22:37-39
